

Tenure-track Faculty Positions in Geosciences

Academia Sinica is the state-funded premier research organization in Taiwan whose 31 research institutions cover the fields of mathematics and physical sciences, life sciences, and humanities and social sciences. A member of Academia Sinica, the Institute of Earth Sciences (IES) has strong and active programs in solid-Earth geology, geophysics and geochemistry, is equipped with state-of-the-art analytical instrumentations and computational facilities, and maintains several field observational networks. Current fields of investigations include seismology, geodynamic modeling, geodesy, regional and global tectonics, gravity and geomagnetic studies, isotope geochemistry, igneous and metamorphic petrology, volcanology, and marine geochemistry. We invite outstanding candidates in the broad field of Earth sciences to apply for several **tenure-track research fellow** positions (equivalent to tenure-track professorship). The appointments will primarily be at the rank of assistant research fellow, but candidates for other ranks will also be considered. Successful candidates must have a Ph.D. degree and an excellent record for conducting independent research.
